He then introduced Dr Gilani (right), Chief of Staff, Eden Psychiatric Unit, who determined that our club is healthy based on his observations of how much we laugh and connect with each other (surprise?!) Dr Gilani described the state of the art facility at Eden Medical Center, and shared his experience of the staff being a community and family. The Eden Psych unit was given an award this year for ranking #1 out of 100 psych units inspected nationwide by Verizon Health. They treated 1274 patients. By 2013 Eden Hospital's new facility will NOT include an inpatient Mental Health Unit. Dr Gilani asked for support from the community to find a solution to the future reduction of Mental Health Services in Alameda County.
